INDOOR / OUTDOOR GUIDE

WHICH BUILD YOUR SIGN NEEDS, AND WHAT CHANGES

Start with where the sign will live

TWO BUILDS

Every design can be built either way. The artwork, the colours and the dimensions are identical — what changes is the neon flex, the dimmer and the power supply. Choosing Outdoor does not change how your sign looks.

INDOOR

Inside, and always dry

- Homes, bars, salons, studios, offices, retail interiors
- Shop windows viewed from outside but mounted inside the glass
- Anywhere the sign is never rained on and never washed down

OUTDOOR

Outside, or exposed to weather

- Shopfronts, signage under an awning, beer gardens, balconies
- Covered outdoor areas that still get wind-driven rain
- Bathrooms, pool rooms and other permanently humid interiors

What actually changes

BUILD DIFFERENCES

LED neon flex	Indoor-grade flex	Outdoor-grade flex
Dimmer	Standard in-line dimmer	Waterproof dimmer
Power supply	Indoor-rated supply, with the plug fitted for your market	Outdoor-rated supply, sized to the length of tube in your sign
Backboard, artwork, colours, dimensions	Identical in both builds	
Free remote & dimmer	Included with every sign, indoor or outdoor	

Compliance marks and electrical approvals are issued against the specific power-supply model fitted to your sign. Ask us before you order and we will confirm in writing which approvals apply to your build.

What an IP rating means

IEC 60529

IP ratings are defined by the international standard IEC 60529. The two digits are read separately.

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FIRST DIGIT — SOLIDS

Dust-tight. No ingress of dust at all.

SECOND DIGIT — WATER

Protected against the effects of temporary immersion in water.

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TOGETHER

IP67: dust-tight, and protected against temporary immersion.

A RATING DESCRIBES ONE COMPONENT, NOT THE WHOLE INSTALLATION

An IP rating describes the part it is quoted against — usually the LED neon flex. It is not a rating of the finished sign, and it does not cover the plug, the power supply or the wall fixings. Those are what the Outdoor build changes. An IP rating is never a licence to submerge a sign.

Installing an outdoor sign

BEFORE YOU ORDER

Power supply and plug	Keep them in a dry, protected position — inside, in a weatherproof enclosure, or under permanent cover.
Electrical work	Have outdoor signs installed by a qualified electrician, in line with the wiring rules where you are.
Fixings	Use fixings suited to the wall material, the sign weight and the exposure. See the Mounting Guide.
Very large signs	A sign over 110 cm is made in sections. Tell us about the mounting surface and we will advise before production.

NOT SURE WHICH ONE YOU NEED?

If the sign will ever be rained on, splashed, or live in a permanently humid room, choose Outdoor. If you are between the two, contact us before ordering — it is far easier to build the right one than to change it afterwards.
